### **ENTRANCE FEE**

All new members (except Junior members) are required to pay an entrance fee. This is a once-off fee.

If a member allows his membership to lapse, the Entrance Fee will again become payable.

Members of the various sports clubs (Tennis, Squash, Hockey etc) will not have to pay the Entrance Fee to HSC, as long as they join HSC (and pay the required fees) within 2 months of their club affiliating to HSC. Should they wish to join HSC at a later stage, the Entrance Fee will become payable.

Junior members must pay the full Junior membership in the years following their joining to keep up their membership. They cannot be 'on/off members' by taking advantage of the No Entrance fee benefit.

### **MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES**

Apart from some special categories, membership is divided into the following categories :

- **Ordinary member:** Over 23 years of age.
- **Student member:** 18 to 23 years.
- **Family member:** These are the spouses or partners or children (6 – 18 years) of a member (who shall be called the Principal member). The Family member's fees are in addition to the Principal member's fees.
- **Junior member:** These are members aged 6 – 18 who are not children of members.
- **International member:** These are members who live in South Africa for less than 3 months of the year.
- **Social member:** These are members who are not attached to a Sports Section but who wish to use the facilities of the club from time to time.

## **SPORTS SECTION FEES**

In addition to the HSC membership fees, the various Sports Sections charge an annual subscription fee. These fees are to pay the expenses of that Sports Section and also to help pay that sections levy towards the running of HSC.

These fees should be paid to HSC together with the HSC membership fees.

At this stage, only Tennis and Squash are affiliated to HSC. Their fees for 2020/2021 are the same.

## **TENNIS AND SQUASH MEMBERSHIP FEES**

Note: Squash members may use the Tennis facilities for free and Tennis members may use the Squash facilities for free.

This means that members of the former Squash and Tennis club do not have to join both the Squash and Tennis Sports Clubs, unless they intend to play league for both clubs. To play league, they must be members of that club.

Members of the other sections and Social members may use these facilities at a reduced rate.

## **New Members Pro Rata**

New Members who join the club more than two months after the start of the financial year will be entitled to a *pro rata* reduction on their fees for that year. On application, the Admin team will advise what the *pro rata* rates are.
